Homework Policy

Our school values the partnership between home and school in fostering students' academic progress and cultivating strong study habits. To support these goals, we have established the following homework policy requirements. We kindly request parents to carefully review the details and encourage their children to complete and submit homework assignments punctually. The policy is outlined below:

- 1. Students are required to diligently record their homework in their handbook each day and complete the assignments according to the instructions provided by their subject teachers. It is essential to submit the homework on time.
- 2. We strongly encourage parents and students to utilise the e-class online homework schedule effectively to keep track of the assignments that need to be completed and submitted.
- 3. In the event that a student fails to submit homework on five occasions, they will be required to attend the central detention class. The detention period will be from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. Failure to attend the detention class without a valid reason will result in a demerit being credited to the student.
- 4. Demerits will be assigned on a term basis for students who fail to submit homework ten times or more. The number of missed homework assignments will be counted individually (e.g., if three homework assignments are not submitted on a particular day, it will be counted as three instances of failure to submit).
